NEIGHBORHOOD SAFETY & HOME SECURITY

It has been brought to our attention that a couple of houses were broken into over the holiday season.

If you are the victim of any crime, please contact the authorities:

- Call 911 in an emergency.
- For non-emergencies, call the Lake County Sheriff's Office at (707) 263-2690 or <u>file a report</u> online.
- Mail theft is a federal crime. For mail theft, contact the United States Postal Inspection Service at (877) 876-2455 or <u>file a report online</u>. If you find mail that you believe was stolen or tampered with, contact your local post office: (707) 279-4562 for Kelseyville.
- Scam emails/texts are a federal crime. Forward suspicious USPS-related emails and texts to spam@uspis.gov, then delete. Report other suspicious emails and texts to the Federal Trade Commission.

To prevent home break-ins, consider installing an alarm system with monitoring services (there are self-monitoring and professional-monitoring options available). An alarm system triggered by motion sensors or glass-breaking sensors can alert you and the authorities while you are away.

Here are some simple things you can do to avoid burglary and theft:

- Keep your garage closed and your vehicles locked.
- Do not leave possessions visible in vehicles.
- Use a locking gas cap.
- Lock your doors, at night and while you're away.
- Close curtains and lock your windows, at night and while you're away; don't leave a window partially open for an outside extension cord.
- Do not leave mail in the mailbox for pick-up any more than necessary, and collect your mail as soon as possible after it's delivered. Mailbox thefts do occur in Buckingham and the Rivieras.
- Keep your travel plans and expensive gift purchases off social media.
- In parking lots, be aware of your surroundings especially at night.
- Keep a photo or video log of valuable possessions and record all serial numbers.
