ABOUT THE VINEYARD

David Hicks planted Ancient Lake Vineyard in 2003 after completing the UC Davis grape-growing and winemaking extension programs.

From 2008–2019, wines produced at the vineyard earned 91 Gold-or-higher awards at major wine competitions.



WHAT'S THE COMMITMENT?

Approximately 14–20 hours per year.

The most important work days are:

- Bird Netting (Late July)
- Harvest, Crush & Fermentation (September–October)

Additional opportunities throughout the year include pruning, vineyard care, bottling, and cellar work.



COST

No membership fees.

Participants only provide their own bottles, corks, and optional labels. All vineyard and winemaking equipment is provided.



LIMITED OPENINGS

Only 3 spots remain.

Participants should live within a reasonable driving distance and have flexibility during harvest season.
