Leash Your Dogs PLEASE

Roaming dogs are a threat to wildlife AND RESIDENTS. Recently, several community members have expressed fear for their safety while walking around the neighborhood due to dogs running loose, displaying aggressive and dangerous behavior — including biting. Please keep your dogs fenced or leashed when they are outside, and stay up to date with their rabies vaccinations. If you are a landlord with a rental property in Buckingham, YOU are responsible for your tenants' compliance with CC&Rs, including pet rules and regulations.

If you encounter a loose dog, please report the incident to the office. Please include: a description of the dog(s) and their behavior, the location, and the owner information if possible. Pet nuisances, including incessant barking, can be fined a minimum of \$50.00 per infraction, but only if we can identify the owner.
