From the Neighborhood Watch

We received the information below from a resident on the lake front of Southlake Dr.

At about 7:20 pm on the night of January 21 a boat was seen in front of Southlake property that registered on residents apple phone as an apple air tag was detected. At 1:20am January 22 resident received the same notification about an apple air tag being detected over their property from a drone. The resident opened the notification and saw a flight pattern above their property creating a zigzag motion and then a straight line back across the lake to Clearlake. Close to Mendo Mill area. The sheriff's department was notified and an incident report was taken. On the NextDoor app - within the last few months residents in the Riverias and along soda bay corridor have reported at least 5 burglaries and one taking place when residents were home. If anyone has seen any drone activity that seems suspicious please contact the sheriffs department. In southern California in November there were a string of burglaries being tied to drone activity. Dones can see inside homes surveilling property looking for cameras and points of entry etc.
